



Rocky Coast Cruises, LLC Charter Party Agreement

This contract is between Rocky Coast Cruises, LLC and (print) _____, who is representing the entire group that is aboard today, (date) _____

This agreement is to charter the boat La Bella Vita, belonging to Rocky Coast Cruises, LLC for a _____ hour sightseeing tour in Casco Bay starting at _____ and ending at _____ for the sum of _____.

If the group wishes to extend their cruise this is possible, time permitting, at a rate of \$60/half hour and \$120/hr.

The group as identified by the representative signing above agrees to follow the rules and guidelines set forth below.

1. The hourly rate: The current 2023 season price is \$120 per hour for the trip including all passengers. There is a minimum of 1 1/2 hours (\$180).
2. Number of passengers: We are certified to carry 6 passengers.
3. Age of passengers and wearing of life jackets: There is a type I offshore life jacket on-board for all adults and children. Anybody 10 years of age or younger is required to always wear a life jacket. Infants should not travel on a boat until they are at least 18 lbs. and can wear a life jacket. This is usually between 4 and 11 months old. You would need to provide your own life jacket for very young group members.
4. Food and drink: You are very welcome to bring along a cooler with all the food and beverages you like. We can stop for a picnic on the boat, or you can eat, drink, and be merry along the way. Please be aware that there is no food or beverage provided other than bottled water. There will be a cooler with ice onboard if you wish to use it.
5. Alcohol Policy: The charter operates under the authority of the captain. The captain has the authority to terminate the charter in the event of unacceptable conduct by the charter party. For reasons of safety and insurance it is prohibited to have liquor and any other beverage in a glass container. The only exception to this is bottles of wine must remain in a secure location (cooler or other appropriate and safe storage space) when not in use. In the event of that members of the charter party become intoxicated to the point that the captain determines that they create a hazard to themselves or others, the charter will be immediately terminated without refund and the boat will return to port
6. Swimming: It is understood that swimming from the boat is not covered by insurance and is therefore not allowed.
7. Payment: Upon returning to the dock payment can be made by cash, check, Zelle, Venmo or PayPal. Paying by credit card is not an option.
8. Cancellations: Can be made by calling or texting Captain Joe at 207 751 6501, the sooner the better. Since no deposit is required, you will not be penalized for a cancellation.
9. Weather related issues: Fog, wind, and inclement weather can affect a good day on the water. Because of this we are willing to work with our customers to either change the time of day, length of cruise, choose a different day or cancel if necessary.
